Class of 2018 Hoopeston Area High School alum Daniel Bass was recently elected to serve as the 2021-22 Wabash College student body president.

He will serve as president of Wabash College's Student Senate during his senior year. Bass will oversee the Student \$387,000 Senate's budget, which is allocated to the College's 70 recognized clubs, student life improve-

ment, and campus events. He will represent 870 students from 31 states and 19 countries during his onevear term.

Rural Hoopeston woman injured in accident Monday

Jana L. Fuller, 29, of rural Hoopeston, was injured in an accident reported at 8:26 a.m. Monday.

According to Vermilion County Sheriff's Department Sgt. Kyle Smitley, Fuller was eastbound on 4200 North, near 1130 East, when her vehicle left the roadway, hitting a mailbox, stump and tree and rolling over before coming to rest.

Fuller was ejected from the vehicle, but was conscious at the scene, Smitley said. She was taken to Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center.

No tickets were issued.

Arrow Ambulance and Hoopeston Fire Department also responded to the scene.

Bass also travelled to Washington DC where he lobbied within the United States House of Representatives and Senate on behalf of agricultural legislation that would benefit Illinois farmers.

Bass will graduate from Wabash College in the Spring of 2022 with a Bachelor of Arts in rhetoric and psychology, with a minor in political science.
