State, city open up as Illinois set to move to Phase 5 Friday

Illinois is set to move to Phase 5 of Gov. JB Pritzker's Covid -19 response plan, Restore Illinois, on June 11. In Phase 5, all economic sectors reopen with businesses, schools, and recreation resuming normal operations with new safety guidance and procedures.

Fully vaccinated people will be able to ditch their masks, except in those places where masks are mandated, such as public transportation and healthcare settings. The state recommends unvaccinated people continue to wear masks. Guidelines for Phase 5 may be found at dph.illinois.gov/covid19/phase-5.

As part of entering Phase 5, the City of Hoopeston will expand the hours that City Hall will be open.

Effective Monday, June 14, 2021, City Hall will be open for walk up service during the following hours:

•Monday – Thursday: 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.

•Friday: 8 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Also, effective immediately, the police department front window will be open each day from 7 a.m. -7p.m.. After 7 p.m., residents may use the intercom system located in front of City Hall to speak with a dispatcher.

Residents are reminded that they can take care of a lot of business by using the city's website, www.cityofhoopeston.com or using the payment drop box at City Hall.

Service by telephone (217) 283-5833 is still available and offices will still be staffed Monday - Friday from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Pritzker has issued 80 Covid-related executive orders since the pandemic began in March 2020. The most recent, issued May 28, is set to expire June 26. In response to that action, Hoopeston Emergency Management Group (HEMG), made up of Mayor Bill Crusinberry, Police Chief Jim DeWitt, Fire Chief Joel Bird and EMA Director Brad Hardcastle, implemented an emergency resolution that was passed by the city council last year.

At an HEMG meeting Wednesday, Hardcastle said once Pritzker's order expires, the city council can vote to rescind the emergency resolution.
