State recognizes sesquicentennial, Hoopes descendant visits

Hoopeston's sesquicentennial is drawing more than residents to celebratory events.

During the kickoff of Sesquicentennial Week Sunday, Illinois Rep. Tom Bennett read a proclamation issued by the state, marking the milestone and outlining Hoopeston's importance as an agricultural community. A descendant of town founder Thomas Hoopes was also on hand to receive a ceremonial key to the city.
