Judges in hairy situation for sesquicentennial beard contest

A field of seven was shaved to four winners in Sunday's Hoopeston Sesquicentennial Beard Contest.

Sponsored by Sue's Shear Design, winners were chosen in four categories: longest beard, fullest beard most well-kept beard and most unique beard and mustache.

Jim Bowers, of Hoopeston, took honors in the most well-kept category with his close-cropped beard and mustache. Erik Gudgel, also of Hoopeston, took the "longest beard" category, while Carroll Jerome took home honors for fullest beard.

Jeremiah Eyrich, of rural Rossville, was deemed to have the most unique facial hair. His wrap-around sideburns and moustache and clean-shaven chin was based on the Burnside, named after Civil War Gen. Ambrose Burnside, who sported the look, which was christened "burnsides." The term was later flipped to become "sideburns."

Eyrich grew the style specifically for the sesquicentennial contest and was itching for it to be gone. Asked if he was going to shave it off, Eyrich replied, "Yes, as soon as I get home."

Gift bags for the winners included both beard oil

and shaving cream. Eyrich handed off the beard oil to his brother, but kept the shaving cream.

HPL starts trial "fine free" policy

Hoopeston Public Library board of trustees has approved a "fine free" policy for a trial period. Effective July 1, the library will no longer charge fines for overdue materials. Items that are lost or damaged will still be charged to the patron's account.

Many libraries across the nation, in an effort to insure more access to their facilities, have stopped collecting fines on overdue materials. The American Library Association recognizes that fear of late fees can deter patrons from returning items or even signing up for a library card in the first place.

Director Tricia Freeland appreciates the library board's support of this change.

"The public library is a valuable resource for our community that residents should not feel reluctant to access," Freeland said. "My hope is that the removal of accruing late fines will encourage more people to use our library."
