At Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Ald. Stephen Eyrich and Mayor Bill Crusinberry lauded the commission's planning and implementation of sesquicentennial activities, held from May 30 through June and culminating with Sesquicentennial Week June 27-July 3.

Alderman gave the commission a round of applause after Eyrich said they did "a fine job. Crusinberry talked of how he appointed "a small committee" for the large task of planning Hoopeston's 150th birthday celebration, also commending them for the job they did.

Commissioners Kristy Kelnhofer, Jeanette Andre and Brad Hardcastle attended the meeting. Other commissioners are Marta Pierce, Debbie Benjamin and Ellen Scharlach.

In other business, the council approved a resolution estimating \$300,000 of Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) work will be done this year.

Ald. Jeff Wise, street/alley committee chairman, said the to-do list was about \$100,000 more than available funds, because of less MFT money due to people traveling less and buying less fuel during the Covid pandemic.
