The words rang deeply in my ears and changed the course of my life forever," McCarty said "But my students have been a continuing source of strength and hope, from students who have listened to my struggles, chipped in around my classroom, or those who made time to help create art for our online sale in 2020. My incredible students surround me every day and make me grateful for the life I have been blessed with."
