Hoopeston Area School Board approves return to in-person learning plan for new year

Hoopeston Area teachers and students will return to the classroom for the new school year.

At a special meeting Wednesday, the district board approved a plan that calls for in-school learning for the vast majority of students. Remote learning will only be provided to students who are non-vaccinated or vaccine ineligible who are under quarantine as directed by the local health department or Illinois Department of Public Health.

Per Gov. J.B. Pritzker's executive order last week, staff and students will wear facemasks for all indoor activities.

To the extent possible, social distancing will be maintained. Areas will be arranged to reinforce dis-

tancing, students will have assigned seating and marked paths of travel in classrooms and corridors will be developed. Sanitation efforts will continue as last year.

When possible, staff will open doors and windows, use child-safe fans and have activities, classes or lunches outside when circumstances allow.

Students and staff who have symptoms of infectious disease, such as influenza or Covid-19, should stay home and contact their healthcare provider for testing and care.

Those who show symptoms of Covid-19 at school should report to or be escorted to the school's office to either be sent home or quarantined in the school's supervised safe area.

Students and staff who are not fully vaccinated should quarantine after a recent exposure to someone with Covid-19. Those who are fully vaccinated and who have been exposed but show no symptoms do not need to be quarantined or tested.

Temperature and symptom checks will be performed on all who enter buses or buildings.

Hoopeston Area is participating in the University of Illinois Shield saliva testing program. Under the voluntary program, students and staff with signed consent forms will be tested twice weekly through the
