Hoopeston large-scale tree removal could begin next week

Work on eliminating a goodly number of Hoopeston's dangerous trees is expected to begin as soon as next week.

At Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Ald. Jeff Wise, chairman of the street/alley committee, said at Tuesday's council meeting that professional tree cutters are expected to be in Hoopeston for a time to fell dead and dying trees.

Street and alley workers have been cutting trees their schedule allows and professionals have been used for some of the work. When tree crews arrive, they will cut trees and it will be "all hands on deck for not only street and alley workers but any who can be spared from cemetery, parks and water departments, to pitch it to remove the fallen trees, Wise said.

In this fiscal year, officials earmarked \$80,000 in the budget specifically for tree removal on city parkways, as well as Floral Hill Cemetery and city parks. Hoopeston keeps a list of trees that should come down and those residents want to come down. Trees on the list have been checked and prioritized, with

trees deemed the most dangerous removed first. The current list of trees will soon be posted at

www.cityofhoopeston.com. Residents who have reported trees on the parkway that are not on the list but which have not been removed are asked to call city

hall, (217) 283-5833 to have tree(s) added again. The city does not remove trees from private property.

In other business, the council heard from Ald. Bob Porth, finance committee chairman, that the annual appropriations ordinance is completed and available at city hall for public inspection.

The ordinance includes the budget plus five percent for contingencies. A public hearing will be held at 6:45 p.m. September 21, prior to the city council meeting. The council will then vote on the ordinance.

Usually approved in July, due to Covid and other factors, the due date for the report was pushed forward, Porth said.
