Sticks and stones

Sticks and other debris are all that's left of a house at 305 S. Second Ave., behind the former Clark Station The dilapidated property was taken down Tuesday. The work was done through a Central Illinois Land Bank (CILB) property demolition/rehabilitation program. The program received a \$125,000 grant from the state, \$100,000 from Hoopeston Retirement Village Foundation and a \$50,000 commitment from the city. Mike Davis, CILB director, earmarked three additional properties as the first group to come down, including 411 W. Penn, 406 Front and 801 Wyman. Two others, a house 210 E. Washington and the former Dyer Mansion at 520 E. Honeywell, are currently in the court system for future demolition.
