Dan 'the Animal Man' Breeding injured, donations sought

A former Hoopeston resident is hoping to get a bit of help from old friends.

Dan Breeding, well-known animal trainer and former resident, was injured in a car accident on September 13 in Raleigh, NC, where he now lives.

According to social media posts from Dan's brother, Ron Breeding, of Lafavette, Ind. Dan, owner of Wild Animal Encounters, was alone in in his animal transport vehicle after having dropped off animals when the accident happened.

The transport vehicle was destroyed and Dan's leg was crushed. He has had one emergency surgery and will need at least one more, as well of months of healing and therapy, Ron wrote.

Injuries prevent "Dan the Animal Man" from caring for his animals and has had to cancel all of his entertainment and education shows for the foreseeable future.

This is the latest setback for Breeden, who lost income last year due to Covid shutdowns. With no money to pay the premiums, his insurance company dropped him. "There are now mounting medical bills, with no insurance and no income," Ron wrote.

"Dan is struggling to pay his facility bills, must replace the transport vehicle and create a plan to pay is medical bills, so he is in dire need of your help," he added.

Ron Breeding has set up a GoFundMe account to raise money for his brother. Online donations may be made at
