Hoopeston Area boosts substitute pay, approves administrative salary/benefits package

Hoopeston Area approved a bump in long-term sub pay in hopes of finding and keeping substitute teachers.

Due to a teacher shortage in Illinois, Hoopeston Area, along with many other districts in the state, use subs not only to cover when a teacher is sick or on maternity leave, but also to place educators in unfilled teaching positions.

The district had been paying substitutes \$90 per day, said Supt. Robert Richardson, adding other districts are paying \$100 to \$105. Vermilion Area Special Education (VASE) is paying \$85 but, Richardson said, the director there said they can't get enough subs.

To remedy the situation, the board approved bumping the pay \$100 per day for days one-five and \$115 for days six-45. On the 46th day, substitutes will become part of the bargaining unit and get the daily rate of the base pay.

The board also approved a reward for retired teachers who return as long-term subs, paying \$115 per day for days one-five and \$125 for days six-45. They, too, will be on the base pay scale starting on day 46.

"We are on the upper end of what county schools pay and that's where we would like to stay," Richardson said, adding the increases would become effective immediately after they were passed.

In related action, the board approved administrative salaries, including a recent hire and two transfers.

Katherine Coulter was recently named assistant middle school principal. She will receive a base salary of \$63,700, with \$6,300 toward retirement, \$9,005.40 toward district health insurance and \$21.60 for district-paid life insurance.

Michelle White, former middle school principal, was named curriculum director at a salary of \$65,520. She will also receive \$6,480 towards retirement, \$9,005.40 towards health insurance and \$21.60 for life insurance.

After White's transfer, Michael Blacketer, was named middle school principal at a base salary of \$70,999.11, plus \$7,021.89 retirement, 9005.40 for health insurance and \$21.60 for life insurance. He was formerly middle school dean of students.

Hoopeston Area praised for reactions shown after injury

A competitor school is praising Hoopeston Area for its reaction to an injury during a recent football game.

At Thursday's district board meeting, Supt. Robert Richardson said that during the HA-Momence game on Sept. 7, one player from each team hit head-to-head. It was a legal hit and the unidentified Cornjerker did not suffer severe injury.

The Momence player, also unidentified, was not as fortunate. The student fell to the field and was unable to get up.

Due to training from AD and athletic trainer Nate Burkowski, coaching staff knew what to do and what not to do. The young man was not moved and EMS was summoned to the Momence field.

The youth was taken to a local hospital, then to a children's hospital, suffering from dislocated vertebrae.

At the field and afterwards, Hoopeston Area players, coaches and others reached out to Momence, actions that were noticed by Supt. Shannon Anderson, who wrote to Richardson, saying the actions taken by

the students and others in the few days after the injury "spoke volumes" about Hoopeston area. He commended the district for "an excellent display of class and a great reminder of why we do what we do."

The story has a happy ending as a day or so later, someone asked if the injured athlete was able to move yet. The answer was he "is on the mend, walking and eager to come to school tomorrow," Richardson related.
