Request for gaming parlor fails in split city council vote

A request for a liquor license to open a new gaming parlor was denied by Hoopeston City Council Tuesday night.

Jeremy Deck owns Deck Realty Group and is co-owner of 4 Corners Insurance, which is located in the former Polson Insurance building, 218 E. Main. He previously expressed concern about goings-on in the downtown area.

With those concerns continuing, Deck decided to move his business to the former Wolfe/Blurton Funeral Home at 907 W. Main.

The rural Rossville resident created a new limited liability corporation, JMBC Amusements, and requested a liquor license from Mayor Bill Crusinberry, who is also Hoopeston's liquor commissioner.

Crusinberry, who had been approached by an unidentified person who wanted to turn the former Pizza Hut into a gambling parlor, that he was against granting licenses for businesses whose chief income stream would be gaming. He also said adding more gaming would hurt longtime businesses who make ends meet with the additional revenue video gaming provides.

Approached by Deck about putting gaming in the building he purchased, Crusinberry said he was sticking with his decision but told Deck the council could overrule him if a super majority of six aldermen approved his request.

In addressing the issue remotely Tuesday, Crusinberry said he thought about changing his mind but decided against. He said he spoke with former Danville Scott Eisenhauer, former Danville mayor, who, Crusinberry said, is also not in favor of gaming parlors for the sake of gambling. "You don't see gaming parlors popping up all over Danville like you do Tilton and Watseka," Crusinberry said.

Allowing Deck's request would set a precedent that would be difficult to control as others would request liquor licenses just to have gambling.

The council was silent for a time after Crusinberry's

comments. Then, Ald. Lourdine Florek asked if he wanted to put the issue to a council vote to decide it. After several more silent moments, Ald. Stephen Eyrich made a motion, which was seconded by Ald. Kellie Ferrell.

In the vote, both voted in favor, along with Ald. Kyle Richards. Voting against were Florek, along with aldermen Joe Garrett, Robin Lawson, Bob Porth and Jeff Wise.

During the public comment section of the meeting, Deck said he didn't see any differentiation between what he wanted to do and what was already allowed at Hoopeston Marathon and Tedd's Beverage Shop.
