Blood drive October 8 to help ARC emergency shortage

The American Red Cross will be in Hoopeston on Friday, October 8 from noon-4 p.m. at First Presbyterian Church.

The Red Cross has fallen into an Emergency Blood Shortage and our blood inventory is the lowest it's been in six years for this time of year, with less than a half a day supply of type O blood and less than a day's supply of certain blood types.

With Covid cases spiking in August, blood donations

decreased, and hospital usage is outpacing what is being collected.

Those who donate in October will receive a link by email to claim a \$5 e-gift card to a merchant of their choice!

Walk-ins are welcome but appointments are preferred. To schedule an appointment, donors can go to www.redcrossblood.org, and use the sponsor code Hoopeston. Masks will be required.
