On September 30, Hoopeston Area lost, 12-25, 25-21, 15-25 to the Timberwolves of Cissna Park. The loss came despite five kills each from Lacie Breymeyer, Bre Crose and Kaitlynn Lange, to go with three solo blocks from Charissa Johnson. The loss put the ladies at 1-4 in Vermilion Valley Conference play.

The Lady Cornjerkers evened their win/loss record at 9 each with a 25-13, 25-23 win over Schlarman Academy on October 4.

The win boosted their conference standing to 2-4 ahead of an October 5 contest, and the team's second three-set loss, this time to Bismarck-Henning/Rossville-Alvin. Coach Brad Jones called the 19-25, 25-13, 20-25 loss a tough one for the team, bringing its record to 9-10 on the season and 2-5 in conference.

The mood was much brighter after the team returned from facing the Iroquois West Raiders Thursday, where the ladies won, 25-10, 25-15.
