

New Dollar General store opens Thursday with larger selections, expanded cooler space

The facial expressions of many shoppers brightened considerable as they walked into Hoopeston's new Dollar General store Thursday morning.

Faces looking glum from the damp and gray outside turned to smiles when shoppers entered the brightly-lit store and saw the expansive aisles filled with new products.

The new Dollar General, at 111 W. Orange, has a greatly-expanded cooler section for items that need to be refrigerated or frozen. Shelves are stocked with canned goods, household products, home décor - currently including Halloween and Christmas items - and hundreds of other goods.

Vickie Beaty, who has managed Rossville and Milford Dollar General stores, and most recently managed Hoopeston's first Dollar General, is the manager of the new store. Thursday morning, she greeted customers and acted as a traffic director, pointing in the direction of the www.iustthefacts.net

Wednesday morning, employees put the final touches on the new store in anticipation of a soft opening in the afternoon. Thursday was the business' first full day of being open to customers.


From a city standpoint, the turnaround time to get the store up and running started in April, when Hoopeston Planning and Zoning Commission approved changing the zoning from industrial to commercial. That action was approved by Hoopeston City Council.

After dirt work was completed, Silver Brothers of Hoopeston poured concrete for the store in mid-July, and See DG on other side

Bulk garbage day, for Hoopeston residents only, will be held from 7:30-10:30 a.m. Saturday at Hoopeston City Hall parking lot. Residents are limited to one load per bulk day and must unload their own load or bring someone to help.

Dumping of electronics, appliances, paint, liquids, tires, batteries, yard waste, construction/demolition material or anything that fits in the provided blue totes is not allowed. Items from apartments with a dumpster will not be allowed and items from businesses and contractors will not be permitted.

in August, the building was erected.

In September, Mayor Bill Crusinberry eliminated a snag that allowed quicker completion of the project. By facilitating an agreement between Dollar General and nearby landowners, his suggestion allowed the store to connect to the city's sanitary sewer system two blocks south of the new store, at no cost to the city.

Dollar General will be open from 8 a.m.-10 p.m. seven days a week.

A grand opening is planned but a date has not been announced.

Hoopeston's original DG, at 415 S. Dixie Hwy., will also remain open.
