The branch fell on and broke a picket fence before hitting the ground. Around Hoopeston, other limbs and branches fell, some landing on powerlines, which resulted in calls to Hoopeston Fire Department. Heavy rains flooded streets, but had mostly receded by Monday morning. As of 9:30 a.m. Monday, total rainfall was 4.35", according to the Just the Facts weather station. Standing water on some rural roads resulted in Hoopeston Area schools being closed for the day. Wind gusts of more than 30 miles per hour were part of the storm, and a wind advisory was issued from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday as the front moved from the area.
