School board gets funding for Chromebook replacement, approves tunnel asbestos work

Hoopeston Area's 1 to 1 technology program has a schedule to replace a percentage of Chromebooks each year. This year, the district will use funds grant funds for the purchase.

At Thursday's meeting, Hoopeston Area School Board unanimously approved purchasing 375 Chromebooks through Technology Resources. The \$129,375 cost will come from the Emergency Connectivity Fund, said Supt. Robert Richardson.

Emergency Connectivity Fund provides funding to help schools and libraries keep students, staff and patrons connected during Covid-19. It is administered by Universal Service Administrative Co. (USAC) with oversight from the Federal Communications Commission.
