District using village concept to help parents help students

Hoopeston Area leaders hope engaging more people will assist parents in helping their kids do better in school.

Building Your Village is a four-part series offering strategies for parents on issues they and their children may be facing. The first session was held September 23 and the second is set for November 4 at Hoopeston Multi Agency, 206 S. First Ave. Doors open at 5:30 p.m., with dinner served shortly after.

The evening's presentation will run from 6:30-7:30 p.m. The district will partner with the Regional Office of Education to provide parents with strategies to help their children cope with anxiety, said Michelle White, district curriculum director. Representatives from local support agencies will attend, as well. Childcare will be available during

the presentation.

Transportation is available upon request.

Those who plan to attend are asked to RSVP by calling 217-283-6161 so enough food is ordered. Those who require transportation may also schedule it at that number.

White said the program stemmed from a conversation between herself and Beth Walder, who wanted to help parents in the community. They created a program removing barriers - such as childcare and transportation - and decided moving it outside the school buildings would be more welcoming for parents.

"New Year's Resolution-Less Fighting: Working with a Strong Willed Child" will be held January 13, followed by "Spring into Self Care" on March 10.
