Illinois State Police, Iroquois state's attorney investigate Danforth officer involved shooting

DANFORTH - A Saturday shooting in rural Danforth is being investigated by the Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigations (DCI) Zone 3.

According to an ISP press release, Iroquois County Sheriff Clinton J. Perzee requested an investigation into the non-fatal officer-involved shooting involving an officer from the Iroquois County Sheriff's Office (ICSO).

On December 3, 2021 at approximately 9:41 p.m., the ICSO responded to a residence in rural Danforth, for a 911 call of a domestic disturbance. The subject, a 40-year-old male of Danforth, was reportedly involved in a domestic dispute with another resident.

While Iroquois County deputies were on scene, the male subject returned. The male subject took actions which endangered the lives of the other residents as well as the deputies. The deputies discharged their weapons striking the subject. Officers immediately rendered aid, and the subject was transported to an area hospital for treatment where he is expected to survive. No officers or other residents were injured during the incident.

According to a release from the Iroquois County Sheriff's department, the male was taken to Riverside Hospital in Kankakee. Along with ISP Department of Investigations, the incident is being investigated by the Iroquois County State's Attorney's Office, which is reviewing the chain of events.

In its press release, ISP said, "This is an active and ongoing investigation, and no additional information will be released at this time."
