Charles William "Bill" Crusinberry, 72, of Hoopeston, passed away at 5:17 p.m. Friday December 17, 2021, at his home.

He was born July 27, 1949, in Danville, IL, the son of Floyd Cecil and Wanda June (Rothgeb) Crusinberry. He married Brenda Kay Denton on March 1, 1999, in Mesa, AZ. She survives in Hoopeston.
