### Cause not determined for blaze at former Coffee Cup

Hoopeston Fire Department arrived Sunday at the former Coffee Cup restaurant, 517 N. Dixie Hwy., to find the building fully ablaze.

But Fire Chief Joel Bird doesn't know why.

The department, along with those from Rossville and Wellington, and Hoopeston Police, were called shortly before 5 p.m. to the scene. Once the fire was extinguished, firemen began investigating and have come up with no reason why the fire began.

"There was no power, there was no gas," Bird said. Asked about speculation on social media that the fire

may have been started by squatters, Bird said there were no signs of any substance that could have ignited.

The fire is still under investigation. Bird discussed it with an Illinois State Fire Marshal representative, both of whom agreed the cause will probably not be

The fire began in a back room of the former local diner, where patrons could grab breakfast after local watering holes closed. More recently, an automotive shop had been there. In recent memory, the building was empty.

Bird said building owner Justin Acton reported he had planned to tear the building down.

Firemen were on the scene for about two hours,

with Rt. 1 closed to traffic from Elm to Penn as the departments worked to put a damper on the flames.

As word of the fire spread, residents converged on McFerren Park, parking along the fence, carefully avoiding guy wires holding lighted Christmas displays in place. Many took to social media to share nostalgic stories of the Coffee Cup.

No injuries were reported.
