As models predict worst case 2 feet of snow, local officials asks for residents help

There's no better barometer for how serious residents think a storm will be than the local grocery store. That was true Monday night at Hoopeston IGA, where the parking lot was full and inside, five check stands were open with a checker and bagger manning each.

Perhaps a less-trusted barometer is the meteorologists, who often get it wrong. Prognosticators are calling for anywhere from eight to 18 inches, but according to National Weather Service information Tuesday morning, Vermilion County can expect a minimum of 13 inches of snow - and a maximum of 23 inches - between late Tuesday night and Thursday. Snow will be coupled with winds gusting to 30 m.p.h. during the storm.

Officials are asking for residents' help in making sure snow can be cleaned as quickly as possible.

- A snow emergency is likely to be called early, implementing the city's snow route restrictions. Vehicles not moved from these streets will be towed at the owners' expense.
- Additionally, Mayor Jeff Wise is asking that all residents who have access to off street parking get

their cars off the street. These vehicles will not be towed, but removing them will accomplish two things: plows will be able to clear streets more quickly and residents' vehicles will not be snowed in by plowing. Residents are also asked to keep garbage cans, trailers and campers off all streets.

• Fire Chief Joel Bird is asking residents who live near fire hydrants to clear snow and ice from around the hydrants. The clear-away zone should be about three feet around the hydrant to allow firefights to work. He also asks that residents clear a path from the hydrant to the street. • "We're going to do our utmost to keep your road open," Grant Township Road Commissioner Dale Lithgow said, of those living in the country. Roads on which no one lives will probably not be plowed, he said, advising people to stay off the roads unless absolutely necessary. If someone gets stuck on a county road, the person should call the road district office, (217) 283-6931 and leave a message where the stuck vehicle is so road crews can avoid the vehicle while plowing. "They say this could be another blizzard of 1978," Lithgow said. "Everyone be safe."
