While there, the group sleeps on the floor of a school room. By 8:30 a.m., after early breakfast and a 45-minute spiritual uplift, the workgroups head to their jobsites with their tools and a sack lunch in hand. After dinner the students enjoy social and motivational programs followed by free time.

This past June the group travelled to Memphis. There, the group assembled desks to be donated to families with children needing the desks for remote schooling. They also painted six apartments for the social service agency Agape (a Greek word for "Love"). These apartments were then provided to single women (often abused) with children. The agency helps prepare the women for potential employment and afterwards helps them find jobs. During the training, the apartments are free but the families then

FRY - Dale Fry, 79, of Hoopeston, passed away at 12:07 a.m. Tuesday Feb. 22, 2022, at his home. He was born August 22, 1942, in Oskaloosa, IA, a son of Frank and Mabel (Seaton) Fry. He married Martha Hedrick on December 22, 1971, in Danville.

Dale is survived by his wife of 50 years, Martha; his daughter, Stephanie (David) Johnson; beloved grandsons, Davis, Meade, and Madden; sisters-in-law, Lois Fry and Mary Chambers; one nephew, Jerry (Zelma) Fry; two nieces, Betty Jo Thornton and Lydia (Chris) Voorhees; and several great-nieces and great-nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Dean Fry; and one brother-in-law, Craig Chambers.

After graduating in 1964 from William Penn University, Dale moved to Hoopeston to teach Social Studies at Hoopeston Junior High.
