A 33-year-old Hoopeston man died of injuries he received in a one-vehicle accident Monday afternoon. Illinois State Police, District 10 reported that Charlie Dickerson III died of fatal injuries received in the accident.

A passenger, 24-year-old Desire Welch, also of Hoopeston, sustained serious injuries and was transported to a regional hospital of life-threatening injuries. Her condition was unknown at press time.

According to police reports Mr. Dickerson was northbound on Rt. 1 and 4000 North when he lost

Council abolishes perpetual care, approves advisory group

Hoopeston City Council approved eliminating the city's perpetual care program at Tuesday's regular meeting.

Ald. Stephen Eyrich, cemetery committee chairman, asked the council to approve eliminating the perpetual care program. By ordinance, the program was designed to be self-funding through interest on initial bequest. However, declining interest rates for several years have not generated enough to cover the cost.

Hoopeston has spent about \$10,000 per year from the general fund to pay for spring and winter grave decorations and \$300 a week watering live urns, he said.

Evrich made a motion to eliminate the perpetual care ordinance and the council agreed, voting 7-0, with Ald. Joe Garrett absent.

With that ordinance put to rest, the council, in a 6-1 vote, resurrected the Citizens Advisory Committee, established by ordinance but left unfilled for several administrations.

The existing ordinance had called for 35 members to be named to the committee by the mayor and approved by the council.

The council had previously discussed lowering the required members to 19, but at the meeting, Ald, Lourdine Florek suggested scrapping the ordinance. She said several groups have been created over the years to improve
