New Casey's General Store slated to open April 21, existing Casey's stores to close April 20

Construction on the new Casey's General Store at Rtes. 1 and 9 is coming along and is expected to open Thursday, April 21.

Joseph Buyno, Casey's Region Director, said last week that a 5 a.m. opening is planned for that day and that a new manager has been hired for the store.

The existing Casey's stores, at 1022 W. Penn and 115 E. Orange, are expected to close sometime Wednesday, April 20, after Casey's inventory team arrives to begin their counts, Buyno said.

Employees of both stores will be absorbed into the new

store, he added. In October, Buyno said about 35 emplovees are needed at the new location.

The new store is larger than either of the existing stores and will more easily accommodate semis and other big trucks.

The new Casey's was brought before Hoopeston City Council in June 2018, when Russ Leigh and Harry Brockus, representing Hoopeston Retirement Village Foundation, asked for the city's help in paying for two planned projects: a truck stop at Rtes. 1 and 9 and a hotel/ restaurant/strip mall on Rt. 9 west of Hoopeston Marathon.


The council approved expanded water and sewer lines at an estimated cost of \$165,000, and then approved another \$175,000 to relocate the Subway store from Hooterville Junction on the east side of Rt. 1 to a new location on the west side. Casey's contributed \$25,000 to the move.

In June 2020, Casey's applied for a building permit, but construction struggled for a few months due to Covid and supply shortages. A ceremonial groundbreaking for the new Casev's was held October 29.
