Ryan Anderson wins gets back-to-back wins at National Farm Machinery Show tractor pulls

A win in February gave Ryan Anderson back-to-back wins at the National Farm Machinery Show tractor pull in Louisville, Ky. It just took three years to do it.

Anderson and his tractor, ✓'n Out, won the event in 2020. The event was cancelled in 2021, but Anderson and

his crew returned this year to again claim the title.

In pulling action February 16, Anderson got second place, then qualified for the finals on February 19. In the finals, he and two other tractors got full pulls, then had to pull again in a pull off, which he won.

Winners are determined by which tractor and driver can pull 60,000 lbs. the farthest distance.

While the Louisville show was canceled in 2021, Anderson, who pulls in the Super Farm Class with the Na-
