County health department to offer free Narcan training

The Partnership To Reduce Opiate Mortality & Promote Training (PROMPT) will hold three free trainings in the use of Narcan, the opioid-overdose-reversal drug, this month at the Vermilion County Health Department.

The training sessions run about an hour, and will be held at:

- 10 a.m. Monday, April 11 (only a few seats left);
- 10 a.m. Tuesday, April 19; and
- 2 p.m. Friday, April 22.

Training can accommodate up to 20 participants per training in the conference room, and each participant will receive at least one Narcan nasal spray.
