Hoping to grow new gardeners, HPL starts new Seed Library

Gardening is a good way to get outdoors, get some exercise, and it makes a fun educational project to do as a family. But for those who have never started a garden before, it can be a little overwhelming - and expensive.

Hoopeston Public Library wants to help more local residents get into gardening - and get more use from its card catalog - with the introduction of its new Seed

The seed library opened this week on the library's main level. Current offerings include radishes, zucchini, basil, asters, zinnias, sunflowers and snapdragons. Obviously, seeds "checked out" from the library can't be returned, but local gardeners are encouraged to bring in their excess seeds to help replenish the library and share with others.

Many seeds can be harvested from flower or vegetable gardens at the end of the growing season, and gardeners will also be encouraged to do that as the seasons progress.

Seed libraries are intended to promote gardening, allow community residents to share their seed resources and to encourage saving seeds for future seasons.

HPL's new startup is being funded in part with donations given in memory of former longtime library staff member Donna Judy, who passed away earlier this year. Seeds were purchased locally at Treasured Roots Flowers, Gifts & Garden. Seeds have also been donated by the University of Illinois Extension's Master Gardeners Program.
