District 1 incumbents hold seats, Bailey to face Pritzker

Familiar names will continue to represent District 1 of the Vermilion County Board, following Tuesday's primary. Incumbents Larry Baughn and Joel Bird, and former member Todd Johnson were the top vote-getters in the field, with 621, 560 and 579, respectively. A fourth candidate, Connor Gilonske, received 135 votes. At the state level, Xenia farmer Darren Bailey secured the Republican gubernatorial candidate slot. Endorsed by former President Donald Trump, Bailey received 442,006 votes - 64.55 percent of the total - far ahead of second place finisher Jesse Sullivan, with 121,039 votes,

for 15.73 percent. Incumbent Democrat J.B. Pritzker received 731,794 votes - 91.77 percent - compared to challenger Beverly Miles with 65,596 votes. Bailey and Pritzker will go head-to-head in the November 8 midterm election. In other state races, Democrat Alexi Giannoulias and Republican Dan Brady will face each other in November to determine which will be Illinois' new secretary of State **See SEATS on other side**

state. Giannoulis garnered 413,802 votes from his party while Brady netted 532,576 from the Republican side.

Republican attorney Thomas DeVore will challenge incumbent Kwame Raoul to be Illinois attorney general. DeVore topped a field of three with 44.33 percent of the total, with 306,620 votes.

Republican Kathy Salvi, with 208,283 votes, topped the seven-person race to try to unseat Democrat Tammy Duckworth, Illinois' junior senator.

In the three-candidate race for U.S. House District 2, Cissna Park resident Thomas Lynch and Shane Cultra, of Onarga, are almost neck-and-neck, with Lynch at 36.9 percent and 9,639 votes and Cultra at 36.2 percent, with 9,454 votes. The winner will face Democrat Robin Kelly in November.
