Police report Medicare phone scam being run in local area

Hoopeston Police Department is warning residents that a Medicare scam is being run in the area.

Residents are receiving phone calls from cloned Hoopeston phone numbers, to appear as if it is a local call. The caller offers a new Medicare card that is just like a driver's license, according to a statement from the police department.

To get this new card, the person must give them their Medicare number and also take a brace, for which the scammer will bill Medicare.

Once scammers have a person's Medicare number, they can then run up medicals bill with it and get medical treatment for people with no identification.

Police said Medicare is aware of the calls. They also remind people to be wary of unsolicited calls and do not provide vital information to anyone over the phone if the caller is not someone you know and trust.

would be able to provide a show or when.

"We actually decided to cancel the show this year," Wise said, "but Elizabeth Silver and Lee Cox didn't want that to happen." The duo did "99% of the fundraising," he added.

Fundraising netted \$24,000 for the show, which will cost \$20,000. The overage will be rolled over into next year's fireworks, Wise said.

Those donating \$2,500-\$5,000 were the City of Hoopeston, Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center, Gibson City Hospital, Iroquois Federal and Russell Leigh & Associates.

Donors in the \$1,000-\$2,499 range were Autumn Fields and Anthem Chevrolet.

HFD responds to Watseka fire

A day after spending several hours fighting a blaze in abandoned Hoopeston building, local firefighters were called early Tuesday to help fight an apartment building fire in Watseka.

Hoopeston Fire Department was among 17 departments that responded when Watseka Fire Department requested mutual aid at 6:33 a.m. for an apartment building fire at 107 N. Fourth St. in the downtown. Hoopeston responded with an engine and ladder companies for staging.

The fire was reported at 5:30 a.m. by an Illinois State Police trooper, who passed the building and saw smoke coming from a window in the 100-year-old two-story apartment building.

High heat and humidity Tuesday taxed firemen, with one requiring treatment for heat exhaustion.

The fire was extinguished by mid-afternoon. Three apartments and two businesses were destroyed, according to reports, and several other businesses received smoke damage.

Seven people were displaced by the fire and are being assisted by the Red Cross.

Fire officials said the building did not have smoke detectors. Residents of the apartment house smelled smoke and were able to evacuate without injury.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.
