Unresponsive attorney slows progress on city issues: mayor

A lack of response from Hoopeston's city attorney has brought some council decisions to a standstill.

"I'm on day 27 of not hearing from our attorney (David Wesner)," said Mayor Jeff Wise at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

His comment was made regarding questions officials have about a proposed ordinance that would impose a \$250 fee on video gaming machines in the city.

Illinois officials approve the fee for non-home rule communities that allow gaming. Half the fee is to be paid by the establishment owner and the other half by the terminal operator.

Ald. Kellie Ferrell is also having difficulty getting a response from Wesner on questions on a new food truck ordinance. That item has been on several recent agendas with no action possible because of unanswered questions.

Wesner, of the Champaign-based law firm Evans, Froehlich, Beth & Chamley, has been Hoopeston's attorney since 2020.

water discharged from wastewater treatment plants.

The issue was discussed at the June 21 meeting, but was erroneously referred to as a water treatment plant problem.

Patel told aldermen that the mandate came from the federal EPA, and that Illinois "is behind some other states in implementing it." He reiterated much of the information shared at the previous meeting, where Wise said a final phosphate level has not been decided and that Fehr Graham put the cost of adding phosphorus-removing capabilities to the sewer plant at \$24 million.





Regarding the price tag, Patel told the council that that the project could be fine-tuned, resulting in a lesser cost. Also, he said, based on Hoopeston's demographics, it qualifies for \$5 million in principle forgiveness and could get as much as \$10 million off if the project is divided into sections.

In unrelated business, the council:

• Heard from Ald. Kyle Richards, parks committee chairman, that golf carts are not to be driven on the grass in city parks. Those found doing so may be ticketed.
