## Council approves three-year police contract, approves gaming fees starting in 2023-24

Hoopeston City Council unanimously approved a three -year contract with Hoopeston Police Department patrol officers.

Officers will receive a 4.75 percent pay increase the first year of the contract and 3.25 and 3 percent, respectively, for years two and three.

This year's raise will be retroactive to May 1, as the previous contract expired April 30.

The percentages will affect all city employees, Ankenbrand said.

Ankenbrand also announced that Officer Andrew Xiong completed his probationary time and is now a fullfledged officer. Xiong was hired July 12, 2021.

In related business, Ankenbrand said four new auxiliary officers were approved, including Mercy Linder, Mark Tyszko, Gage Cloud and Logan Garrett, and that a new squad car arrived. Its graphics have been applied but the vehicle is still waiting on electronics, he said.

In other action, the council unanimously approved Jesse Gonzalez and new Ward 3 alderman. He replaces Lourdine Florek, who stepped down May 6.

Gonzalez will chair the city's street and alley, said Mayor Jeff Wise.

Ald. Stephen Eyrich, who was moved from the cemetery committee to the street and alley committee when Wise became mayor, was named to replace Florek as chairman of the water/sewer committee.

In his final report as street and alley chairman, Eyrich said seeding along Thompson Ave. is expected to be done August 8. He also thanked his department and the parks department for getting rid of stumps in the park. He had previously said the stumps could be a danger during the National Sweetcorn Festival.

In other action, the council:

Heard from Ald. Kyle Richards that the parks committee approved a \$100 rental fee for McFerren Park - equal to the \$25 per shelter rental fee - when the entire park is rented for an event. Charging the fee would be at the discretion of the council, Richards said, with Wise adding that for nonprofits or things that benefit the entire community, "we can waive it."

Asked by Ankenbrand for a skate park update, Richards said the Silver Brothers will do concrete work but has been busy. As for the features that will go in the skate park, Richards expects them in "Octoberish." A representative of the company providing the features reported

this year has been the busiest in the company's history.

Unanimously approved a fee for gaming machines. No fee will be implemented this year, Wise said. Next year, half the fee - \$125 - will go into effect, followed by the full \$250 fee in 2024-25.

Illinois approved a law allowing the fee for gaming operations in non-home rule communities. Half the fee is to be paid by the business owner and half by the terminal operator.

Approved hiring Steve Miller as the new city attorney. He will consult with former city attorney David Wesner on issues facing the city. Miller, who has a Hoopeston office, "will be at the meetings," Wise said.
