Neighbors pitch in to welcome guest house to Chestnut St.

If the neighbors are willing to pitch in, you know they welcome a new business to their block.

Such was the case for Lulu's Place, a new guest house at 826 E. Chestnut, which was spearheaded by Susan Comstock.

Comstock's history with the house goes back more than 20 years. "I sold this house to Lu (Lula Lewis) 23 years ago," said Comstock, who sold real estate at the time. "I just loved her so much and since I name everything, it was the only name I wanted, just a little take on Lula," she said, adding that Mrs. Lewis is now in a nursing home.

Comstock does not own the house. It is owned by Two

States Investments, LLC, an Indiana-based corporation. Tom O'Malley, formerly of Milford, is the registered agent for the corporation, which was formed in March.

Two States Investments "owns everything I'm involved with," Comstock said. That includes the Mil-INN in Milford, as well as Honeywell Apartments in Hoopeston.

The house was initially purchased as a rental, but because of the neighborhood, Comstock said she thought it would be better as a guest house. "It's a nice, quiet area with most people being (home) owners," she said.



regarding large gatherings and underage drinking parties, according to a press release issued Wednesday morning. Youngsters use social media, such as SnapChat, Instagram, Facebook, etc., to send out digital flyers to a party.

Creators of the flyers then give a location, usually via GPS pindrops, to notify the group of the party's location. Since the technology is virtually instantaneous, the group can be redirected to a new location easily if they believe law enforcement has become aware of it. Due to GPS, people can go to locations that would otherwise be unknown to non-local residents. Last summer, deputies came across a party on a rural Cissna Park road that had more than 300 people gathered. Approximately two weeks ago, a deputy on patrol came across a gathering on a rural Milford road that had more than 150 attendees. "These parties are taking place on weekday, as well as weekends and are occurring regularly," the release said.

There are few rules for the 2 bedroom guest house: no smoking. Small dogs are allowed, but no cats and guests are asked to be respectful of the neighborhood. There is a two-night minimum, as well.

While not officially opened then, Lulu's Place had guests last week and even had newlyweds stay for their honeymoon, she said. An open house Saturday resulted in bookings for future stays, she said.


