HA board approves spending nearly \$500,000 on bleachers

In an ongoing effort to improve its athletic facilities, Hoopeston Area School Board on Thursday approved spending nearly a half million dollars on new bleachers.

The board approved a \$492,595 bid for outside stadium bleachers from Texas-based Southern Bleacher Company, Inc.

Officials have discussed new bleachers, as well as other improvements that would make outdoor athletics spaces more handicapped-accessible, including a hard surface approach that would be wheelchair-friendly.

At the August meeting, the board discussed using a financial strategy that could be used to fund big-ticket items, like a club house, by using working cash bonds that the district would buy, thereby reaping the interest from them.

Hoopeston Area first used this means of funding major projects in 2016, when, when it approved \$900,000 in

working cash bonds to borrow money in anticipation of the state freezing property tax levels for two years.

The debt was repaid over three years, using an increased tax levy.

The board approved the working cash bonds, which requires a public hearing, rather than seeking a bond issue from the voters, many which were not being passed.

The district did the same thing again in 2018, issuing another \$900,000 in working cash bonds to fund major needs in the district, including replacing Maple School's
