# HA high school students learn about water at Aquality Solutions for Manufacturing Day

Some Hoopeston Area High School students got an up close look at a local industry during Thursday's Manufacturing Day.

Students Lyndsie Blakey, Raven Armstrong, Bryson Brewer, Megan McAllister, Brian Armstrong, Chris Khuns, Josh Merhley, Arias Cipra, and AJ Jones toured Aquality Solutions, accompanied by chaperones Alex Goudy, Luke Lawson, Rusty Campbell and Nicole VanHyfte of Vermilion Advantage.

Tim George, Aquality's sales manager, hosted the group as they toured the plant and learned about what makes water hard and what hard water does to waterdriven appliances and pipes. Students saw the testing process to determine how hard water is, how much iron and total minerals were in the sample. They also learned the benefits of soft water

Students learned what a softener is and how it works to soften our water. They also watched our water production in progress as it flowed through our softeners, carbon filter, UV filter, ozone treatment and bottling. They saw the bottle inspection, sanitizing, filling and capping. They learned about reverse osmosis and all the minerals it removes to make water that may not have been fit to drink so it is drinkable and safe.

"They were amazed at the amounts of salt and water we deliver daily and they left with a bottle of Hoopeston High School water," George said. " It was a pleasure sharing our business with them."
