Ankenbrand moves from Hoopeston, resigns council seat

Carl Ankenbrand announced his resignation from Hoopeston City Council at the group's November 1 meeting. The resignation was necessary after he moved outside the city limits.

Ankenbrand was named to the council in October 2002 on a recommendation from then-Mayor Chalmers Flint. He served until April 2021, when he lost his bid for re-election to Kellie Ferrell. He returned to the council this April, appointed after Jeff Wise resigned his seat to become mayor.

Appointed to fill the remainder of Wise's aldermanic term, Ankenbrand would have had to run for the seat in the 2023 election.

By statute, Wise has 60 days to recommend someone to replace Ankenbrand. The council then has 30 days to act on the recommendation.

Anyone in Ward 2 interested in running for the seat may pick up a petition packet at Hoopeston City Hall.

Packets are also available for other seats, including

- Mayor: two-year term, to fill the unexpired term of former Mayor Bill Crusinberry
- Ward I Alderman: four-year term, currently held by Stephen Eyrich
- Ward III Alderman, two-year term currently held by Jesse Gonzalez; four-year term currently held by Joe Garrett
- Ward IV Alderman, four-year term, currently held by Robin Lawson

Petition packets may be picked up at Hoopeston City Hall during normal business hours, Mon-Thurs. 8 a.m. - 3 p.m. and Fri., 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Petitions must be filed between December 12-19, 2022.
