Downtown businesspeople mourn death of man who brought smiles, greetings to Main St.

A bit of kindness died last week with the passing of Stephen Eugene Johnson.

Many Hoopeston residents may not have known his name, but anyone who spent time during the day driving downtown probably noticed the man who daily walked from his Centennial Manor apartment up Third St. and west on Main, waving, smiling and telling people "hi."

News of Mr. Johnson's death Wednesday sent shockwaves among downtown business owners and employees.

"When we opened in March of 2020, we had no idea how blessed we would become by the relationships we would make with our customers," said Emily Brown, owner of 112 Wine & Coffee Shoppe.

"One unforgettable regular patron was our good friend, Stephen," who came into the shop several times each day, for coffee, snacks and meals. "At first, he was a little shy with us, but soon he knew the names of every employee," Brown said. "He joked and laughed with us and became part of our 112 family. Other customers began to build relationships with him, too.

"Stephan walked up and down Main Street all day, greeting people and sharing his beautiful smile with everyone he met," she said. He "became very special to each of our employees, so that we noticed if he didn't come in for a few hours.

"We hope that Stephan enjoyed his time with us at 112, but the truth is, he gave us more than we could have ever given him. Every time he stepped through the door at 112, he brought us joy and happiness. May you rest in peace, Dear Stephen. You will always be a part of the 112 family. We will miss you forever, friend."

The shop announced on its Facebook page that the

business will close from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Wednesday to "celebrate the life of a special customer and friend."

Bill and Jennifer Lind met Mr. Johnson when they purchased Pizza King last year. "He was already a regular customer," Jennifer Lind said. "The first thing we noticed was so polite and kind he was. He would always ask permission before he sat down, even if he was our only customer at the time. We will all greatly miss him and his kindness and know that he is smiling and waving at everyone from above, just as he did here."

Robin Lawson, of Mr. B's Café, also commented that Mr. Johnson is smiling down on Hoopeston. "We can be sure Heaven is smiling and wave down on Main Street in Hoopeston from now on," she said.

"We never spoke a word to each other, but I would look forward to seeing him sitting around the corner
