Former Hoopeston Area student named Secondary School Assistant Principal in Colorado

A former Hoopeston resident has won a top honor from a Colorado education group.

Jimmy Chism was recently named the 2023 Secondary School Assistant Principal of the Year. The award, given by the Colorado Association of School Executives, (CASE) is a highly competitive honor.

A 2004 Hoopeston Area High School graduate, he went on to earn a BS in education from Illinois State University, an M.Ed from Arizona State University and, in 2022, he became a Doctor of Education, graduating

from the University of Colorado Denver.

Chism is currently assistant principal at Hidden Lake High School, an alternative school in Westminster, CO, where he has served since 2020. The 2,400-pupil school is geared towards helping students recover credits and graduate with a high school diploma.

Principal James Steward nominated him for the award. "He earned it through his actions," Steward said in a video announcing Chism's honor. "It's not just words that Jimmy does. It's his actions that I seem him doing, his actions that the staff sees him doing, that actions that the students see him doing, and they trust him."

"I've always tended to gravitate toward more vulnerable populations," Chism said of his career choices, which have included special education students, those on a Native American reservation, "and now alternative kiddos." he said.

In 2008-09, he was a special education aide in McLean County Unit District 5. From there, he moved to Baboquivari High School in Tucson, AZ, first as a high school teacher of both remedial and honors courses. In 2014, he was named assistant principal and athletic direc-

tor at the school. He left in 2015 to become assistant principal at Westminster High School before moving to his current position in

In the video announcing his award, Chism talked about the difficulties of working with those vulnerable students and the time it takes to build trust so that the students will participate in class activities. His patience paid off, however, as the video shows him interacting with students during passing periods and in the office. One student, Damian Diaz, said in the video that Chism "tries to find something relatable, like football," to connect with students. "He makes it enjoyable to come to school," he said.

Chism will be recognized this spring at the 2023 CASE Awards Reception. He will also represent Colorado at the NASSP National Principals Conference this summer and be eligible for the National Secondary School Principal of the Year award.

He is the son of Vickie Beaty, of Hoopeston.
