Board to consider Hoopeston, other requests for ARPA funds

The Vermilion County Board's finance and personnel committee is reviewing a basket of wants from the county's share of pandemic-related federal funds, including \$937,000 for infrastructure and a demolition project in Hoopeston.

If granted, Hoopeston would use the money to put in place infrastructure for a planned hotel on Rt. 9 and also demolish empty buildings in the 200 block of East Main.

Other requests for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds include:

• more than \$1.3 million in water-related improvements in Allerton, Fairmount, Ridge Farm, Sidell and Westville. • \$500,000 for house rehabilitations, requested by Cen-

tral Illinois Land Bank Authority.

• \$500,000 to construct a new building at the Vermilion County Fairgrounds.

Hoopeston Fire Department was called at 7 p.m. Wednesday for a smell of natural gas in the 400 block of East Main.


No gas leak was found and no injuries reported.
