

Storm threatens area with bitter cold, high winds, drifting snow

A winter storm could pack a wallop for central Illinois later this week.

The National Weather Service (NWS) on Monday issued a special weather statement for several central Illinois counties, including Vermilion, warning that a very strong storm system is expected to bring "significant weather impacts" to central and southeast Illinois beginning Wednesday night and Thursday morning and continuing through Saturday.

Wind chills of -10 to -30 are possible, along with strong winds and accumulating and blowing and drifting snow are possible with the storm

Watch for signs of frostbit or hypothermia. If you need to shovel, take breaks often and push, rather than lift, snow. Other tips include:

- Have non-perishable food and bottled water on hand.
- \bullet Have a secondary heat source in case the power goes out
- Keep a fire extinguisher and smoke/carbon monoxide detector on hand.
- Bring pets indoors or provide shelter and fresh water. Keep salt away from paws.
- If you must travel, check your vehicle's battery, coolant and tires and make sure to have jumper cables and a blanket.
- Check on elderly neighbors and friends, especially those who live alone.
