Area fire departments fight two simultaneous house fires

Hoopeston Fire Department, as well as several other area departments, braced bitter cold temperatures Thursday night fighting two simultaneous house fires on opposite sides of the city.

The first call came in at 10:17 p.m., when first responders were called to the 800 block of South Fifth St. Rankin-East Lynn, Rossville and Bismarck departments were also summoned to the fire, which destroved the home.

At 10:25 p.m., the second fire was reported in the 600 block of East Young. Hoopeston police and fire department answered the call, along with Wellington-Greer and Milford fire departments. That home, too, was destroyed.

Fire and police personnel not only had to split manpower between the two fires, but do so in sub-zero temperatures, with wind gusts of up to 50 m.p.h. and wind chills of -50 degrees. Pictures taken at the scene show firemen in frozen gear with ice covered mustaches and beards. A photo taken at one of the fire scenes displays water that froze as it dripped on out-

In a post on social media. Fire Chief Joel Bird reflected on 2022 fire statistics, writing that this year's call volume is the highest the department has ever seen. The normal average is 120-130 calls per year, but this year, HFD responded to 175 calls as of Christmas Eve. The department averages six to eight structure fires per year, but are at 30 for the year, Bird wrote.

Both fires remain under investigation.
