# Kaitlyn Coffey named Miss Hoopeston 2023, others honored at Community Awards event

In November, Kaitlyn Coffey wore oversized ears and a red cap as the elf at Hoopeston Chamber's Magical Express. Saturday afternoon, Coffey got something new to wear atop her head: the 2023 Miss Hoopeston crown.

Coffey, 19, was named Miss Hoopeston from a field of three candidates, including Emma Glotzbach, named first runner-up, and Tara Sullivan, named second runner-up.

As Miss Hoopeston, Coffey will represent Hoopeston at various events this year and will the hostess for this year's National Sweetheart Pageant.

The 19-year-old is the daughter of Chad and Amy Coffey. A 2022 graduate of Hoopeston Area High School, she currently attends Eastern Illinois University.

A panel of judges interviewed the contestants and the public got to weigh in through the People's Choice component, which allowed people to vote online for their favorite contestant, at \$1 per vote. Those attending the pageant were also able to vote until the end of the event's intermission.
