Winter storm expected today

The full force of the storm that resulted in a winter storm warning that became effective last night is not expected to be felt until today.

The National Weather Service issued the warning Monday, effective from 9 p.m. Tuesday to 6 p.m. Wednesday.

A chance of snow was predicted for Tuesday evening. with accumulation of 1" to 2" possible. Heavy snow is expected today, with new accumulations of 3" to 5".

Forecasters put the chance of precipitation at 90 percent Tuesday and 100 percent Wednesday, with northeast winds today of 14-17 mph., gusting to 25 mph.

If the forecast is accurate, residents can expect snow routes to be activated. By ordinance, a snow emergency may be called when snow reaches a depth of 1.5". Then, vehicles parked on streets in the snow route must be removed. Owners that fail to do so may be ticketed and their vehicles towed.

Penn from Rt. 1 to Euclid:

Main from Rt. 1 to Eighth St. and Euclid,

Fifth from Rt. 9 to Honeywell. Maple from Fifth St. to Third St. Third St. from Maple to Lincoln Lincoln from Third St. to Fifth St.

Market from Rt. 9 to north of Hoopeston

Sixth Ave. from Rt. 9 to Main Eighth St. from Penn to Main
