# City council approves big-dollar water/sewer expenditures

In 6-0 votes, Hoopeston City Council approved some high-dollar items for the city's water/sewer department.

Ald. Stephen Eyrich, water/sewer chairman, outlined each of the expenses, which include:

• A not-to-exceed \$3 million low-interest Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) loan for repairs and upgrades to the water system, the water treatment plant and water main replacement on Market St. from Main to Honeywell. Eyrich said the mains there - including one that recently broke outside Russ Leigh's office - were installed in 1888, making then 135 years old.

Aside from offering low interest, Hoopeston's economy has been such that the city has qualified for 40 per-

cent principle forgiveness.

- Related to that, the council approved Task Order #7, an agreement with Donahue & Associates to oversee aspects the project at cost not to exceed \$103,300.
- A second task order, #8, was approved at a total cost of \$28,500 for Donahue's work in preparing a vision statement, water source assessment, objectives and action plan for a Source Water Protection Plan mandated by the IE-PA.

Donahue is to have a draft plan completed for city review by June 1. A workshop will be held in mid-June with city officials to review the draft plan, with a final plan submitted to the city by July 1. Comments from the city will be incorporated in the final version, which is to be submitted to IEPA by July 20.

• Software that will calculate what Hoopeston water/sewer rates should be to keep the department solvent. The Waterworks program will cost \$6,450 annually. After a motion was made by Eyrich and seconded by Ald. Kellie Ferrell, Ald. Bob Porth, finance committee chairman, said, "If it says we have to raise rates, you have to stand behind it."

Mayor Jeff Wise quickly added that there was no guarantee the program would recommend increasing rates.

- A water-meter ordering mix-up in which 500 water meters ordered last May did not arrive until last month after 400 were ordered last fall resulted in an extra \$116,000 expense. Considering the rising cost of goods, Eyrich wanted to keep the meters. "If you ordered them now, they'd be more than \$232 apiece," he said. He met with Ald. Bob Porth, finance chairman, to work out a way to keep and pay for the meter bonanza. The department found the money to pay for meters and will not order any next fiscal year, Eyrich said.
- The council also approved purchasing seven new fire hydrants for a total cost of \$23,952
- A 2022 Chevrolet Colorado will be joining the water department fleet. Purchased from Anthem Chevrolet, the

vehicle is costing \$30,045. The new truck was budgeted at \$40,000, with the cost split between the water and sewer departments, Eyrich said.

• The final expense was to fix a pump at the pump house. The work was "in dire need," Eyrich said. When the pump was returned, the motor worked, but the pump did not, requiring a second repair. The total for both was \$5.035.

Eyrich, along with Porth, Ferrell, Jesse Gonzalez, Robin Lawson and Rachelle Miller voted to approve the expenditures. Aldermen Kyle Richards and Joe Garrett were absent.
