Dignitaries celebrate opening of new Iroquois Federal office

Hoopeston's new Iroquois Federal office is just a stone's throw south of its old one, but has so much more to offer customers.

"The main reason we moved was that we had outgrown the old building, said Dean Grimes, Iroquois Federal vice president and Hoopeston branch manager. The new facility, at 655 S. Dixie Hwy., is approximately 3,000 sq. ft.,

while the old one was less than 2,000, he said.

The Hoopeston office now has six employees and is looking to add a part time teller. The new building has three teller stations, Grimes said.

Customers will like that the new site has two drive-up lanes and 15 parking spaces, "which is a huge upgrade
