# Hoopeston City Council hears report on nuisances caused by geese at McFerren Park

In the 1980s, Hoopeston made the news for an invasion of starlings.

In 2023, the city is plagued by another invasion most fowl: geese.

April Jones, who chairs the city's Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) reported last Tuesday on the issue of geese at McFerren Park.

Residents have complained about the number of geese, the noise and manure left by the birds. Suggestions to alleviate the problem included:

Signs at the park telling residents not to feed the geese.

Spraying grape-flavored powdered beverage mix in

the area where they congregate or in the water where they swim.

Installing a green laser in some fashion to discourage geese from being in the park.

Place predator decoys around the park.

Playing an annoying noise

Place strobe lights in different areas of the park.

Ald. Kyle Richards interjected after Jones' suggestion of predator decoys with, saying, "That will never work."

Mayor Jeff Wise agreed, saying those options were

unsuccessful in ridding Urbana of geese.

Ald. Joe Garrett suggested calling the Illinois Department of Natural Resources which may migratory fowl to be removed under certain situations during hunting season.

A final suggestion was to have a biologist study the situation and make recommendations on how to encourage the birds to leave.

Also regarding the park, Jones said the CAC recommends an area of McFerren Park be created just for toddlers and their parents.
