Lorraine to become speakeasy for murder mystery dinner

Hearken back to the days when gin was made in bathtubs and gangsters ruled as the Lorraine Theatre offers up a whodunit over dinner.

On Saturday, March 11, guests will be welcomed to the Lorraine Theatre's 1922 Speakeasy, sure to be the event of the century!

This Murder Mystery Dinner takes you back to the roaring twenties as Jazz-Age flappers flouted Prohibition laws and the Harlem Renaissance redefined arts and culture.

The Seven Corpse Dinner will be presented by Champaign-Urbana Theater Company with jazz-themed music played by local supporter Theta Lee.

The "Lorraine Speakeasy" is requesting, but not requiring attendees to wear 1920's themed apparel. Awards to

be given for best-dressed couple, gangster, and flapper. Period related vehicles will be parked at the theatre the day of the event, as well.

The meal, with a 1920s flare, will be catered by Applewood Foods, of Covington, Ind. Hors d'oeuvres will include marinated olives and cheese plate.

The dinner portion will begin with a mixed greens salad with Asian vinaigrette. The main course features bourbon baked ham, cheesy potatoes, and roasted vegetables followed up with a pineapple upside down cake for dessert.

The meal will include each guest's choice of bottled water or a fountain drink. There will also be the option to purchase giggle juice for adult attendees.
