Family hopes to find items stolen in February break-in

Carol Hicks has taken time in her life to improve Hoopeston, from volunteering for many community organizations to researching and sharing information about our community from its birth until the present.

On February 10, more than time was taken from Hicks, as thieves broke in to her home. Fortunately, she was not there at the time, but several items were taken, many with more sentimental than monetary value.
