## Hoopeston, economic leaders get tour of motel renovations

City and economic development leaders were invited Wednesday to see the improvements being made to the former Downtown Motel.

Owner Sabah Yokhana led the tour from the basement to the upper floor of rooms, explaining modifications as he went. In the basement, all new lines were installed, as well as a new water heating system.

When he first bought the motel. sight unseen, in 2020, Yokhana said he discovered the sewer pipe from 112 Wine & Coffee Shoppe next door had been cut. The basement was filled with sludge, which had to be pumped out and the basement cleaned.

Being a good neighbor, Yokhana approved a connection from 112 to his new line to save 112 owners Bob and Emily Brown the expense of having to have a trench dug and a separate line installed.

In another example of neighborliness, he installed a temporary restroom for workers, rather than have them using facilities at 112 or New Beginnings Church.

Moving up from the basement,

the tour group entered moved to the west side of the parking lot, where Yokhana will have the motel office. Although only the skeleton of the rooms is visible, he clearly sees where everything will be when it's done, including an area for copiers, where televisions will be installed, and other amenities.

When it's finished, the motel will have suites and

regular rooms, each with a combination heat/air conditioning unit. Plans also include onsite washers and dryers for guests. A security system will be installed so that only guests will have access to rooms.

None of the plans are in blueprint form, Yokhana told the group. "It's all in my head," he said. Renova-See MOTEL on other side

tions are taking a while to complete but will be done properly. "I want to do it one time and be done with it," he told tour guests.

Renovations began soon after Yokhana bought the building. A new roof was put on and new windows and fire doors installed for each room.

Yokhana came to the United States from Iraq. "I'm a Chaldean, like in the bible," he said in 2020 The country was plagued by war and other issues at the time. "There was no future for my kids," he said. After the Gulf War, he moved his family to America. "I got the best future for my kids," said the father of four and grandfather of 11.
