# Brian Silver sells part of Silver Bros. but keeps it in the family

A longtime Hoopeston business has become two separate businesses, but will remain a family operation.

Brian Silver, owner of Silver Brothers Construction and Ready-Mix Concrete, recently sold the concrete part of the business to cousin Justin Silver, of Rossville. The sale was announced last week.

The Silver family business started in 1879 as a contractor/stone masonry firm. The ready mix portion was added in 1948, said Silver, who purchased the business from his father, David, and is now in his fourth year of ownership. It is that part of the family business that Silver sold, to his cousin, Justin Silver, of Rossville.

The road to the split began about three years ago, when Brian Silver needed employees and could not find good ones. "I didn't think it would be this hard to find employees," he said.

He asked Justin - who was farming and selling commercial insurance - to come work in the family endeavor. He agreed, and became a driver, hauling sand and operating the cement truck "and stuff like that," he said.. And on March 13, he became the owner of Silver Brothers

"It means a lot to keep this in the family," Brian Silver said. The cousins are the sixth generation of Silvers to operate the firm, including both their grandfathers, Dan and Jack Silver. The history is not lost on customers. either. Area contractor James Thomas told Justin that his grandfather, Jack, used to used deliver concrete to him, and now Justin is doing the same.

While each will oversee their own area, there will be projects where both will be needed. "I'm the mixer." Justin said. He will mix and pour concrete and Brian can continue to set up forms and finish it.

There are still some details to iron out. For example, both businesses will be using the same phone number, (217) 283-7751, although Brian hopes to have a "push 1 for ready mix and 2 for construction" system in place. His wife, Holly, will do double duty for a while as other details are decided.

By splitting the business, each man can concentrate on his area, providing the best product and service to customers, Brian said.

At 39 and 26, respectively, Brian and Justin Silver have several years before they need to consider turning Silver Brothers over to the next generation, but it's a thought each has considered.

Brian, father of Dillon, 12, and Olivia, seven, said he would like to see his line continue in the business "if it works out that way."

Justin, and his wife, Anna, have a son, Zevin, who will turn two in May. "(Zevin) loves the equipment," his dad said. "He just wants to sit in the truck," he said.
